While meals are free of charge to all students through the fall, it is still important for families who qualify for free or reduced price school meals to apply for that help. Being approved now will ensure a smooth transition when this special program ends at the end of December. This information is also used to help determine funding for school programs and can provide your family with discounts for Chromebook insurance, childcare, and internet services. We've made changes to keep students and staff safe. Here's what you need to know:

- Staff received training to ensure that they wash their hands, wear masks and gloves, quarantine when not well, and continue all of the safety precautions that we follow even when there isn't a pandemic.
- Cafeteria serving lines have been fitted with plexiglass shields at points where staff and students cannot maintain 6-feet of separation.
- Students will come to the cafeteria to get their meal and will take it to their classroom - or to another space designated by the principal - to eat.
- We will pack meals into take-out boxes and hand them directly to students.
- Students have a choice of entrees, but we will automatically add vegetable and fruit side dishes to everyone's lunch box.
- A choice of chocolate or white milk will be offered with meals.
- Condiment packets will be provided in place of shared use bottles.
- Maintaining an account balance may not be necessary while school meals are free for all students. If you need to submit a payment, payments are no longer accepted at school. Please pay on-line at www.MySchoolBucks.com or mail checks to: SCASD FSD, 653 Westerly Parkway, State College, PA 16801.
- Menus will no longer be sent home from school. Menus are posted at www.scasd.org/schoolmeals, and electronic copies will be emailed to families each month.

Every meal includes a choice of milk.

The USDA program that allows us to provide free meals to all students does not cover the cost of milk for students who pack a lunch. Packers can choose to take a fruit and vegetable with their milk, the minimum required components of a meal, and receive those items for free.
