Please help us before you leave for the summer . . .


Summer Shut Down:

For the past 5 summers, the Physical Plant Team has asked for your help in reducing summer energy consumption. Thanks to your help the district has saved over \$120,000.00 through these efforts.

The classic example of summer waste would be a refrigerator that runs all summer to keep a few condiments fresh. Every building is different and in order to be effective, this type of program requires close coordination.

In many cases, simply turning electrical items off does not completely stop their power draw. Phone chargers, radios, printers and many other items need to be unplugged to completely stop their power usage.
