Following are a number of writing prompts. Your job is to select **ONE** of the prompts and write a complete, coherent, and correct essay. Your essay should have an introduction, a body, and a conclusion. Remember that your introduction should do three things: state your topic/thesis, forecast your paper, and hook your reader.

I encourage you to take the time to write up a formal outline (which you may use in class). You may find it difficult to write a complete essay on some of these prompts, so choose carefully and spend the time prewriting.

2. Delta has a requirement of 30 hours of community service hours a year. Given that community service is all about volunteering, should Delta require this service of their students?
