

## ***The Art of War Presentations***

*The Art of War* is an important piece of writing, but you don't need to read the entire document to get a flavor of its style and message. Now that we've read the first chapter together, we are going to divide and conquer (would Sun Tzu approve?). You may be working with a partner on this small project, or you may work alone: your choice.

Select one chapter from the text (I'm going to try to avoid repeats and still have the remaining 12 chapters covered). Read it several times, thoroughly. For each chapter you must write a one-page summary. Afterwards, you need to create the following:

- Identify the elements of this chapter that are still applicable. Provide examples from war, business, dating, you pick it. Whatever words for your approach.
- Identify the elements that are no longer applicable (or must be modified) given technology, environment, our global community, etc. Again, provide examples from current times.
- Synthesize this chapter into one sentence. This may be difficult for some of the chapters because there are a number of exceptions Sun Tzu puts in place. I want to see your focus here in one complete, coherent, and grammatically correct sentence.

Chapters will present in five minutes.
