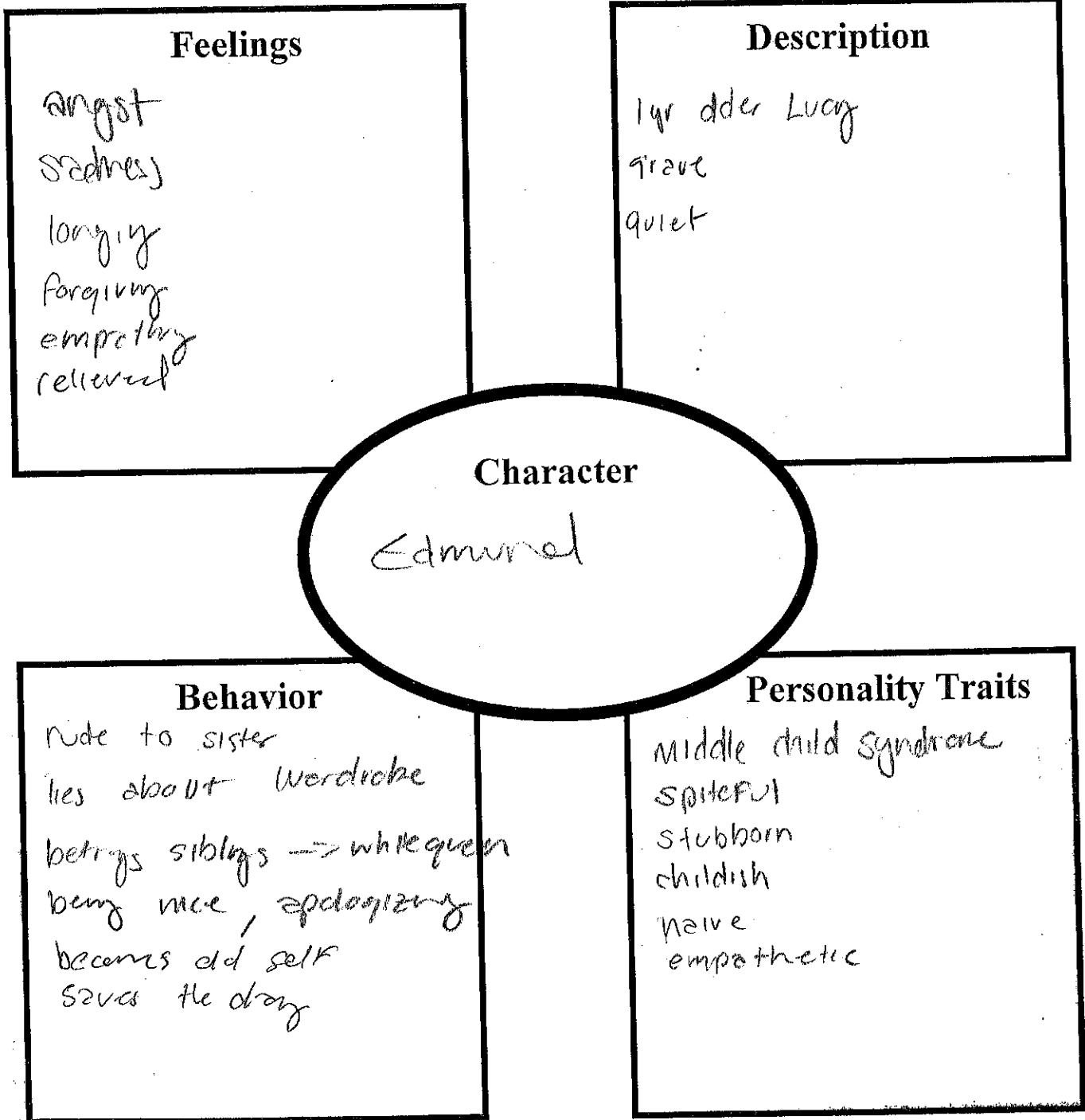

Character Name: Edmund Pages in the text: 47-107

At least two events that happen in this section of reading that involve your character (include page numbers):

1. Kids finding the wardrobe Pg 60
2. Edmund going to the Queens Castle (chapter 9) 95-107

How your character responded to those events (his/her behavior):

1. He got yelled at by Peter for being rude to Lucy & responded by being snarky
2. He gets scared by the statues but tells the queen everything

Two important things that your character said that show something about him/her and his/her perceptions, actions, thoughts, dreams, etc. (exact quotes, include page numbers):

1. "I've brought them quite close. They're in the little house on top of the dam, just up the river - with Mr. & Mrs. BEARD." 107 Shows he's motivated by nice people & food & will go against his siblings
2. "He thought more & more about how he hated Peter - just as if all this had been Peter's fault." 99. He can't take the blame & he's spiteful

In what ways has your character changed or not?

He became even more of a traitor, he's still childish. He becomes angrier.

Character Name: Edmund Pages in the text: 109-158

At least two events that happen in this section of reading that involve your character (include page numbers):

1. "'Prepare the victim'... knife being sharpened." - 150
2. "'Here is your brother,' he said 'there is no need to talk to him about what is past.'" - 153

How your character responded to those events (his/her behavior):

1. There was no said reaction but he was relieved when he was saved.
2. After his conversation with Aslan Edmund's attitude completely changed

Two important things that your character said that show something about him/her and his/her perceptions, actions, thoughts, dreams, etc. (exact quotes, include page numbers):

1. "'Im sorry.'" - 153 This shows Edmund is maturing & realizes his wrong doing.
2. "'Oh dont, dont, please dont.'" this shows that Edmund is looking out for others & not just himself, he tries to stop the Queen from turning people into stone.

In what ways has your character changed or not?
He came back to his siblings after being abused by the witch & he was nice to them. He says that he finally feels sorry for somebody other than himself.

At least two events that happen in this section of reading that involve your character (include page numbers):

1. Stopped the witch from turning people into statues (Pg 195)
2. Aslan & knights Edmund (Pg 197)

How your character responded to those events (his/her behavior):

1. Saved the day
2. He became happy & his old self again.

Two important things that your character said that show something about him/her and his/her perceptions, actions, thoughts, dreams, etc. (exact quotes, include page numbers):

1. "It was all Edmund's doing... We'd have been beaten if it weren't for him" - 195, Peter says this. It shows Edmund cares about his fan.
2. "I have such desire to find the significance of this thing that I would not know by my good will turn back for the richest jewel in all Narnia & all the islands." - 204, not as motivated by greed. In what ways has your character changed or not?

He became his happy self again - no longer motivated by greed & wants to do things out of curiosity & not pure want.
