

## Writers' Toolbox Presentation

You will be designing and delivering a formal presentation based on your research topic. A presentation is similar to a paper in many ways:

- It should capture your audience's attention
- It should thoroughly inform without overwhelming
- It should be organized
- It should be grammatically sound
- It must have an MLA works cited page

Here are the specific expectations for your power point (you may use what ever tool is available to you):

- At least five slides (including cover and works cited)
- It should be visually interesting and clear
- Each slide should have one illustration/graphic
- There should be an excellent sense of organization for all the slides and individual slides
- Text should be kept to a minimal amount
- All text should be grammatically correct

Here are the specific expectations for the over all presentation:

- The speaker must introduce him/herself
- It presentation must be spoken, not read
- The speaker must demonstrate a mastery of the subject
- The speaker must speak clearly and slowly
- The speaker must ask if there are any questions (and then answer them)

The slide show is worth 35 points and the oral portion is worth 10 points (total 45 points)
