The following are expectations:***

2nd Semester Student Expectations

- 6 Projects - 3 completed in the 3rd 9 week marking period, 3 completed in the 4th 9 weeks
- 5 Planning sheets completed and approved by me **before** purchasing supplies, Remember you are now a 2nd or 3rd semester student and your projects must contain a greater degree of difficulty than do those of 1st year students. Projects will be turned in according to the timeline, if multiple projects are turned in right before a marking period is ending, points will be deducted for lateness.

Each project must contain one or more of the following:

- **Dart(s)**
- **Set in Sleeves**
- **Attached waistband or interfaced facing band**
- **Pocket(s) - set in or side seam**
- **Zipper- centered, lapped or invisible**
- **Buttons and button holes**
- **Collar or hood**
- **Pleats**
- **Lining**
- **Hand Stitched Hem**
- **Monogramming or machine embroidery work**

Independent and assisted work everyday, 5 points will be deducted from the possible 125 points for each day you are not working on course work or projects.

- **You are required to be on time for class. Attendance is taken on line as the bell rings. If you are not in the room you will be marked unexcused. If you have more than three unexcused absences, FOR ANY REASON, you will serve 1 hour of after-school detention.**

3rd + Semester Student Expectations:

- **All of the above 2nd semester student requirements, plus**

Each project must include two or more of the following

- *Dart(s)
 - *Set in Sleeves
 - *Attached waist band or interfaced facing
 - *Pocket(s)
 - *Zipper, centered, lapped or invisible
 - *Buttons and button holes
 - *Collar/ hood
 - *Pleats
 - *Lining
 - *Hand stitched hem
 - *Monogramming or Machine embroidery work
- Projects are to be turned in according to the timeline for success. If multiple projects are turned in right before the end of a marking period, points will be deducted for lateness.

All projects must be pre-approved by the instructor before supplies are purchased and a completed planning sheet and shopping list must accompany the finished project.
