Music Coordinator's Report: The US Navy Jazz Commodore concert was excellent. State High Marching Band performing at Beaver Stadium - halftime only; no pre or post game. Tri-M will be helping PFMS with ticket-taking at CCMEA fest (November 13 & 14) - only have a few student commitments. We need at least eight people. Austin Van Allen is on the steering committee for middle level curriculum programming and was present to share - meeting on November 1st; survey to go out to parents, staff, and students for feedback for music and arts programs; would be beneficial for Music Boosters to complete survey; committee hoping to make recommendation to the board by March; survey going out between Thanksgiving and Christmas

Updates on Current Business:

- a. Marching Band Update: Beaver Stadium Classic game on Saturday
- b. Sousaphone Covers: should be arriving tomorrow
- c. *Old Uniform Upcycling*: three sets were sent to CA for free samples to be made; hope to have samples by November 23rd to sell at Holiday Bazaar

New Business:

- a. Nominations for November elections of Executive Board: Terra Deyo agreed to stay on as Secretary for another term. Janie Schaumburg will be President. Rebecca Clayton may be willing to be Vice-President. Pat Hillard is interested in the Treasurer position.
- b. Would like to have a liaison from each elementary PTO who comes to our meetings and reports back to their PTO.
- c. Pat Hillard would like a liaison with the charter and private schools in the area to share SCAHS music information. A Music/Arts Open House for the community with Q&A would be ideal. Would need to be in January in order to inform people in time for course scheduling. Erik Clayton suggested a tri-fold brochure be created to hand out.
- d. Adjudication: April 16-19; Symphonic Band, Advanced Strings, Advanced Rock Ensemble, Jazz Band, Master Singers, OMA, and Cecilian Singers travel, sightsee, and perform at Adjudication in Boston, MA; transportation costs have increased to about \$20,000; try to keep cost to families to \$500 or less usually, but \$320 for hotel plus \$150 per student transportation; does not include tickets to anything; \$35-65 for concert; all would be approximately \$550; some chaperone cost; asking for booster support for chaperone cost = deficit of \$3,619; 11 chaperones plus 3 directors; driver's rooms and breakfast at hotel; lodging, fee, banquet, dance; could shorten by a night to bring costs down, but it's more of a hassle for not much price difference; Boosters commits to \$100 per chaperone and we are open to more when we have more concrete numbers in January; Terra will send out account balance reminders
