- Science projects should list all materials and methods used.
- If you use photos of information from other sources, please give credit.
- Collections should be clearly labeled.
- Inventions should include an explanation of what they do.
- Enjoy your projects! Your teachers, parents and classmates look forward to seeing what you've learned!

Projects should be brought to school for set-up on Sunday February 23, 5-7 p.m. Classes will view the displays during the school day on Monday. Late entries will also be accepted before the fair, 6-6:30 p.m.
