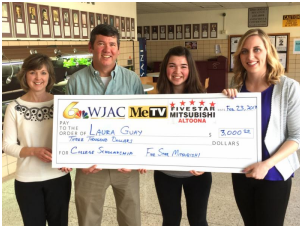
## Jump Rope for Heart
