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## Our Week of Learning

We had another great week in Room 10! The children are so close to filling our class gumball machine, and even though we are going full remote this coming week, the children will still be able to earn gumballs. They will earn gumballs by following our **Remote Learning Norms: Be on Time, Stay in Your Learning Space, Mute Yourself, Turn on Your Video, Be Prepared, Raise Your Hand to Talk, and Be Respectful.** We will discuss these norms on Tuesday.

We will start our day at 8:15. Please make sure your child has a learning space with as few distractions as possible, and the materials he/she brought home on Thursday nearby. I will also show the children where to find the attendance check-in. It will also be in Clever under Mrs. Sutherland's page. Please be patient and understanding as we all adjust to this new format. We will all try our best!

### Highlights from the Week:

- **Beetle Glyphs:** The children created beetle glyphs to represent personal information. Afterwards, the children sorted the beetle glyphs in a variety of ways. Later in the week, the children worked on making picture graphs to represent data collected.
- **The Chocolate Touch:** Ask your child about our class read aloud. Who is the main character? What has happened so far in the story? What does your child think the main character's problem is going to be?
- **Learning A-Z (Raz Plus):** This is a resource we will be using for reading. It contains thousands of leveled books. More information will be forthcoming.
- **Writing Workshop:** The children worked on writing a small moment story for me. They were to write a story in a way that shows off all they know about narrative writing. Ask your child what he/she chose to write about.
