



**State College Area School District Community Education** offers full day camps for youth in Grades 1-6 (Fall 2023). Students will choose two educational short-term enrichment classes for morning activities\* and are divided into age-appropriate groups for afternoon activities that include recreational games, crafts and water play. *\*Students will register for classes later in the spring. Brief details about offerings can be found on the next page.*

**DATES:** Weekly from June 19 to August 11 (no camp Monday or Tuesday 7/3 or 7/4); sign up for one week or all eight weeks!

**TIMES:**

**Half Day** - 9:15 a.m. - 12:05 p.m. Choose two educational shorts\*

**Full Day** - 9:15 a.m. - 5:30 p.m. Includes two educational shorts\* in the morning and recreational activities in the afternoon. Drop off is from 9:00 a.m. - 9:15 a.m.

**Extended Day Morning** - 7:30 a.m. to 9:00 a.m.

Classes begin promptly at 9:20 a.m.



Educational Shorts\* - Class 1 is from 9:20 a.m. to 10:20 a.m.; Class 2 is from 11:00a.m. to 12:00 p.m.; students have time for a snack and recess in between classes

Recreational Sports - 12:05 p.m. to 5:30 p.m. for Full Day participants

**LOCATION:** Mount Nittany Elementary School

**FEES:** Half Day - \$125 per week (Week 3 \$75)  
 Full Day - \$225 per week (\$135 Week 3)  
 Extended Day Morning - \$20 per week (\$12 Week 3), not available in August

**NOTES:** Parents provide transportation. ~ Students must bring a lunch, two snacks and drinks (all products must be nut-free). ~ There is limited enrollment in each course; registrations are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. ~ Students will be grouped by age/grade for afternoon activities. ~ Course offerings are subject to change. ~ The district's Health and Safety Plan will be followed.

## MORNING ENRICHMENT OFFERINGS

At this time, you will merely be registering for specific weeks of Shorts & Sports. *Class* registration will take place later in the spring. Each morning consists of two 60-minute classes, which run between 9:20 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. each day (Black Rocket classes are held from 9:00 to noon each day). We are excited to partner with Adam Swartz Puppets, Discovery Space, Happy Valley Chinese School, Lincoln Caverns, Movin' Into Engineering and Soccer Shots, as well as SCASD teachers (noted with an \* below), to offer STEM, art, physical activity and language/culture activities this summer. More information regarding specific offerings will be sent to registered individuals via email later in the spring, so please keep an eye out for more details! Below is a tentative schedule of when each provider will be with us; providers will offer classes for both students in rising Grades 1-3 and Grades 4-6 unless otherwise noted. Classes and providers are subject to change.

## REGISTRATION BEGINS MONDAY, FEBRUARY 20 AT 10:00 A.M.

Visit [www.scasd.org/SummerCamps](http://www.scasd.org/SummerCamps) and click the **Register Now** button.

If you are a new user, click *Create New Account* at the bottom of the screen and follow the on-screen prompts. Be sure to include emergency contact info and pertinent medical info. Returning users should log in and update emergency information before selecting classes. (NOTE: Our registration system is separate from ParentVue.)

Once logged in, click Summer Camps from the left navigation panel. Select the week for which you would like to register. Select the student(s) who will be attending this camp. You will see programs being added to your cart in the upper right hand corner.

Continue adding weeks to your cart as needed. Scroll down to add AM Extended Day programming for corresponding weeks, if desired. Review your selections and click **Checkout** to continue.

## PAYMENT AND WAIVER DETAILS

At the time of registration, you will be asked to review and agree to the following waiver. Please read it carefully prior to registering.

- The District's Health & Safety Plan will be followed.
- You must complete a cancellation/change of schedule form for all cancellations or change requests. You can find this form at [www.scasd.org/SummerCamps](http://www.scasd.org/SummerCamps).
- No refunds are granted for cancellations made with less than TEN BUSINESS DAYS' notification prior to the start of a course.
- All cancellations are subject to a \$20 cancellation fee per student, per camp.
  - If you cancel and you have paid in full, you will be charged a fee for the refund equal to 5% of the refund amount, not to exceed \$100.
  - There will be no reduction in fees if your child does not attend the program for any reason (ie - due to illness, behavior, etc).
- You are responsible for keeping an updated card on file for the payment plan and any additional fees you may incur. If your payment fails, you will receive a system-generated email notification. You must log in to your account, update your card and process the appropriate payment amount. Accounts with a balance due five (5) days after the payment due date will be assessed a late fee of \$25. Should your balance due remain unpaid three (3) business days after this fee is assessed, your child's future camp enrollments will be cancelled and you will receive no refund.
- You will receive a confirmation email upon successful registration.

**PAYMENT** Payment may be made with a Visa or MasterCard. There is a non-refundable \$25 registration fee per student. If you register before the end of April, you will have the option of putting your invoice on a payment plan. Registrations that take place on May 1 or later must be paid in full at the time of registration.

**PAYMENT PLANS** Payment plans carry a one-time fee of \$10, paid at the time of registration. If you would like to utilize the payment plan option, on the **Payment** page, select the Payment Plan button located in the Select a Payment Option box. Click the button and your invoice will be divided into 2 monthly payments, May 16 and June 16, 2023. Specific dates and payment amounts can be viewed by clicking the Details drop down next to the payment plan button. You will pay only a 3% deposit today plus the payment plan fee. ***If you fail to put the invoice on a payment plan, you will pay the entire invoice. Should you inadvertently do this and require a refund, you will be charged a fee equal to 5% of the refunded amount, not to exceed \$100.*** Additionally, should you ever inadvertently pay more than you intend and require a refund, you will be charged this fee. Please read everything carefully prior to checking out and contact our office if you have any questions.

**STUDENTS WITH SPECIAL NEEDS** If your child has an IEP or 504 plan, has a chronic health condition or exceptional needs, please contact the Special Education office to ensure that your child's needs can be met while at camp. Your child's Special Education team may make additional recommendations based on your child's needs.

**PRIVACY POLICY** SCASD Community Education does not share your personal information with other organizations and/or individuals. Your personal and financial information is collected for the sole purpose of registering and paying for Community Education courses and communications regarding future offerings.
