| 3. Membership | 1. Members will be residents of the school district or employed by a business with a major facility in the State College Area School District. |
|  | 2. The committee will consist of nine regular members and three ex-officio members as follows: <br> a. four members from the business/real estate areas in the school district <br> b. two members of the school district staff <br> c. two members community/at large |


| 4. Membership |  |
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| Selection | d. one member who is a general executive at The Pennsylvania State University <br> e. three ex-officio members who will be the Business Administrator, <br> Accounting Director, and one school board member |
| 5. Length of Service | 1. Solicit candidates through advertising. Board Members and administrators may <br> submit names. <br> 2. The Superintendent will review applicants and submit recommendations to the <br> Board. <br> 3. The full Board will approve and appoint all regular members. <br> Regular members of the committee will serve a term of two years. Length of service <br> on the committee will be limited to two terms. |
| 6. Leadership | The chairperson will be determined by the committee and provide leadership for the <br> committee, in coordination with the Business Administrator, and provide <br> communications to the Board. |
| 7. Meetings | Meetings will be held with dates and times to be determined by the membership. <br> Authorized expenses will be paid by the school district. |
