## Cardboard Candy Dispenser

### **Part Specifications:**

T x W x L = Thickness x Width x Length

(") = inches: All measurements are in inches.

Materials): Corrugated cardboard, paperboard (ex: cereal box), hot glue, ring, and jar

Base Layer (bottom)): 1" x 4" x 7.25"

- You may make it with 8 single layers stacked and glued or make it skeletal like the one I made. The skeletal base will more intense to make but will be stronger and more stable.

Layer 2): 1 x 4 x 4 = 8 pieces stacked and glued.

Layer 3): 2 sides, each slide: 1 x 1.375 x 4 = 8 pieces each stacked and glued.

Slider): .75 x 1.125 x 8 = 6-9 pieces stacked and glued.

- Be sure slider is thinner than the two side pieces. It needs to move back and forth.
- Use a nickel to layout the holes.
- I used thinner but stronger cardboard for this part, hence the reason I used 9 total.

Slider Peg/Stopper): 1" long, .25" diameter, glue into the slider .25" deep

- You may design a different way to stop the slider from the back.

Top-Part A): 1 x 4 x 4 = 5 pieces stacked and glued, 2.75" hole

Top-Part B): 1 x 4 x 4 = 5 pieces stacked and glued, 2" hole

Dish): This is completely up to you.

Handle): This is completely up to you. However, it will need to stop the slider from the front.

Ring): Regular mouth size jar ring

Jar): Regular mouth size jar
