They will review the alphabet and the spelling conventions of Modern Standard Arabic and continue developing the four language skills: listening, speaking, reading and writing. Students continue to develop their understanding of the multiplicity of the Arabic language in order to prepare them for the complex reality of the language. They will continue to study topics related to self, daily life and Arabic culture. Instructional methods are in line with current best teaching practices, including the use of technology and the inclusion of cultural concepts and how they are embedded in language. Assessments include proficiency checks, oral and written activities, quizzes, tests and projects.
