

Booster Club Meeting Notes

Treasurer Update: Mara Ryan stepped down as treasurer as her daughter, Emma, will not be playing this season. After weeks of reaching out to parents to volunteer, Patricia Lally agreed to serve as treasurer for the SCGLAX Booster Club. We agreed to have Dorothea Stahl and Mara Ryan removed from the bank account and have Janelle Moyer and Patricia Lally added to the account.

A motion to approve Patricia Lally as treasurer was motioned by Vivian Angus and seconded by Barbie Collins. The board unanimously voted in favor of Patricia Lally to serve as treasurer for the 2021 season.

With a copy of these minutes, Janelle Moyer, president, will work with the bank to make the necessary signature changes to the SCFCU account.

Discussion Topics:

Hudl Videotaping: Janelle participated in a boys teams meeting along with Chris Weakland about beginning a trial of Hudl to tape and live stream the girls and boys lacrosse games. Hudl also provides game statistics for the coaches.

Tryouts will be March 8 - 11, 2021 from 6:00-8:00 p.m. Following the three days of evaluations, players will be assigned to junior varsity and varsity teams. At the time of this meeting, 32 girls showed proof of interest in trying out, with 6 seniors included in those numbers. The teams will be announced on March 13.

Uniform Distribution will take place on March 17 at 5:30 p.m. in the parking lot. Those volunteering to help with distribution are Vivian, Maureen, Bob, and Barbie. They are to meet at the parking lot at 5:00 p.m. Items to be disbursed are shooting shirts, new Pinnies, sweatpants, and backpacks.

Meet the Players and Coaches will take place briefly following practice on March 17. Player checks will be collected (\$125 per player) that evening. Families will be asked to bring cases of Gatorade (A-L) and water (M-Z) which Jeff will collect and store.

Team photos will take place on March 25 at 6:00 p.m. at the North Field Turf. Maureen will coordinate the photographer as well as forms. The team composite will be done using individual photos.

The Team Store is currently ready to go live and will be announced to players and parents following tryouts.

Game programs – It was decided for 2021, that programs would be created in digital form only. A QR code will be supplied for parents and fans to download the roster.

Away game meals – The booster club will provide meals for every away game. SCASD will be the vendor to supply the bagged meals for \$5 a bag. Included are a sub, water, cookie, fruit, and chips. The players will need to choose their type of sandwich once but for all games. Debbie Krentzman will assist with food distribution. Because of Covid-19, there will be no sharing of food or other food collected for the players.

Face Masks - It was agreed that the board will not cover the cost of individual face masks for players and that players will need to provide at least two personal masks. Suggested colors for games are gray, black, or burgundy.

Budget - There is approximately \$11,000 in the bank account. Expenses will be food, banquet/picnic, and senior gifts.
