

Musical Theater Project

1. The Musical Theater Project is due by _____.
2. You may pick the musical but it must be approved by Mrs. McAninch – first.
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Project selections include:

1. **Diorama** - depict a scene from a musical **integrating the information into the design**.
2. **Poster** - Draw a scene from a musical. **Integrate the information into the artistic design**. For a better grade use a 3-D approach using fabric, yarn, glitter, metallic paper, etc. Remember: you don't have to use white poster board. Posters must be 18"x24" or larger.
3. Five or more **puzzles** relating to a specific musical, composer, etc. There should be a variety of puzzles - crosswords, word searches, acrostics, mazes, riddles. There should be **original artwork**, a **summary** and a **cover page**.
4. A 5-page **report** about a musical or a composer of musicals. The report should be interesting and have **original artwork**. Consider a "magazine" with several articles about various aspects of the musical.
5. **Mobile** - Must relate to a musical. **Integrate the information into the artistic design**, as well as, symbols from the musical. Your design must include a way to hang the mobile.
6. **Live performance** - 3 selections from a musical to be performed (sung or played on an instrument) in class. Your presentation **should include a brief summary of the plot, composer, lyricist, characters, and song titles**. You should also explain how each song fits into the musical.
7. **PowerPoint** presentation – **Ten or more slides**. Please cite the source for all photos and copyrighted images below the artwork. You must **also** include **original artwork**.
8. **Scrapbook** about a musical or a composer of musicals - You must **integrate the information into the design**. You must have **original artwork**.
9. OR You can create your own project.

Your project must be creative, informative, and original!

1. Creative - use color, glitter, material, original drawings, 3-D design, costume, etc.
2. Informative - include **title, composer(s), lyricist(s), characters, and song titles**.
3. Original - **no photocopies or internet copies**. All artwork must be created by the student.

Your project will be graded on content, originality and creativity and neatness.
