## SUPPLY LIST FOR 2023-2024



One of our goals this year is to help students get organized and be ready to do their best each day. The following items may be purchased before school begins. **Please DO NOT STRESS if you cannot find something or don't have everything for the first day!** If this supply list causes hardship for your family, please don't hesitate to contact your child's teacher or counselor. Please check exploratory teachers for their supply lists (Language, Tech Ed, Health, etc)

### GENERAL INDIVIDUAL SUPPLIES - used for multiple classes (carry in backpack unless otherwise noted)

- Large pencil pouch
- Glue sticks (2 or 3)
- Sharpened pencils** (at least 2 dozen - replenish throughout the year)
- Erasers or pencil top erasers
- Highlighters
- Colored Pencils
- Lined paper
- Pair of earbuds or headphones
- Pens

### SUPPLIES TO USE WITH YOUR ENGLISH TEACHERS:

- 3-ring binder with paper (will stay in classroom)

### SUPPLIES TO USE WITH YOUR SOCIAL STUDIES TEACHER:

- 3-ring binder with extra notebook paper (can be used for multiple classes- see note at bottom about binders)

### SUPPLIES TO USE WITH YOUR SCIENCE TEACHER:

- Binder/folder
- Composition journal
- Ruler
- Color pencils

### SUPPLIES TO USE WITH YOUR MATH TEACHER:

- One inch binder (or section of larger binder)
- Ruler
- Graph paper
- [Scientific calculator](#) (Link takes you to examples)
- One subject spiral notebook
- 4 pack of Thick Black Dry Erase Markers (for classroom use)

**SUPPLIES TO USE WITH YOUR ACADEMIC LITERACY TEACHER:**

- Binder (individual or section of larger binder)

**SUPPLIES TO USE WITH YOUR ART TEACHER:**

- Two pocket folder
- 9x12 sketchbook

**SUPPLIES TO USE WITH YOUR MUSIC TEACHER:**

- Three-prong folder

**OPTIONAL INDIVIDUAL SUPPLIES:**

- Individual pencil sharpener that contains the shavings
- Chromebook Case
- Markers (classrooms have shared ones as well)

**ENCOURAGED SUPPLIES TO SHARE WITH HOMEROOM:**

- Box of tissues
- Clorox Wipes

**LOCKER & BACKPACK INFORMATION:** *Please keep in mind that the lockers are only 7.5 inches wide. Large items and backpacks (including those with wheels) will not fit!* Students may not put glass mirrors, stickers, tape, etc. in their locker. Magnets and plastic accessories are ok to a minimum.

**A note about binders:** To help students be organized in seventh grade, binders are essential. There are several ways students utilize binders and sometimes it takes experimentation to find a method that works best for you. One way is to have a binder for each subject. Another way is to have an "A Day" binder and a "B Day" binder. Some students have binders for the classes they have back to back (ex/ math block 5/6 and science block 7/8). If using a binder for multiple classes, dividers are recommended.
